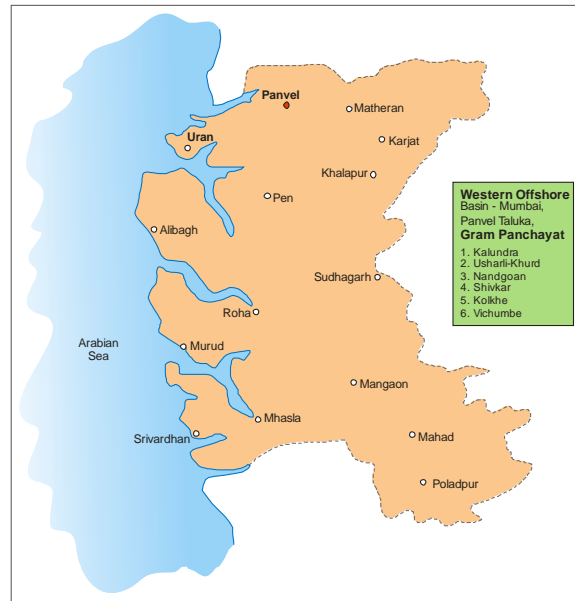

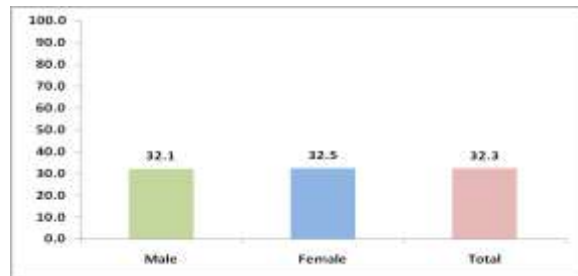
Background

Mumbai ONGC has operations in four different directions of the mega-city. After visiting all the four areas the target villages near Panvel were identified in consultation with the concerned ONGC officials. Accordingly, the survey was conducted to identify all households with elderly persons (aged 55 years and above) in the selected villages. Details are available in Table 1.1.

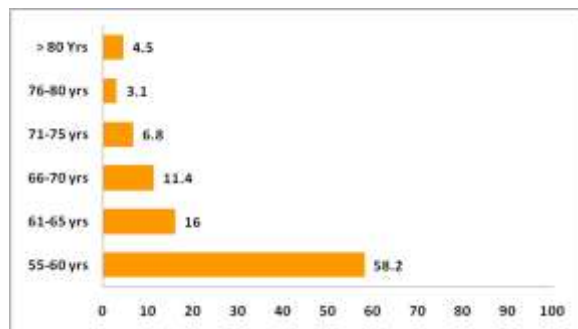


Demography

Of all the 1323 households, more than 14.5% are Below Poverty Line (BPL) whereas the rest (almost 85.5%) belong to the Above Poverty Line (APL) category. Out of the total members of all the surveyed households, elders constitute more than 32%. Male elders are more than 32% and female elders are 32.5%. Details are available in Table 2.1.



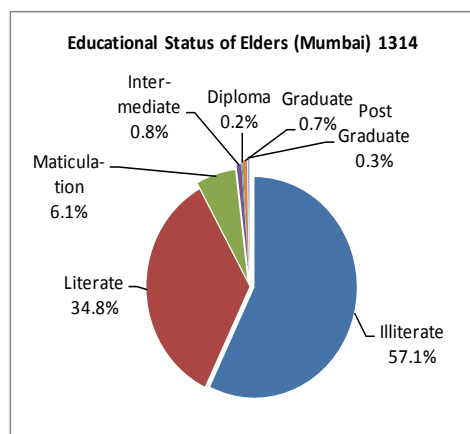
When one looks at the percentages of elders in different age groups, the 'above 80 years' category is at the bottom and the percentage increases with each successive younger age group among elders except in case of 76-80 age group which is lesser than the '>80 years' group. The percentage of the youngest age group among elders is the highest among all. Details are available in Table 2.2 to Table 2.3.



Education

Data on educational status on elders reveal that more than 57% are illiterate and out of the rest almost 35% are just literate. Matriculates are more than 6%. All other categories are all below 1% level. Details are available in Table 3.1 to Table 3.8.

Out of all elders more than 67% are not working. Among non-working elders percentages of women elders across all age groups are far more than men elders. At the other end, across all age groups of elders the percentages of working elder men are far above working elder women. Working men were found across all age categories and working women were not found in the three eldest age groups. More details are in Table 4.1 to 4.2.



Disability

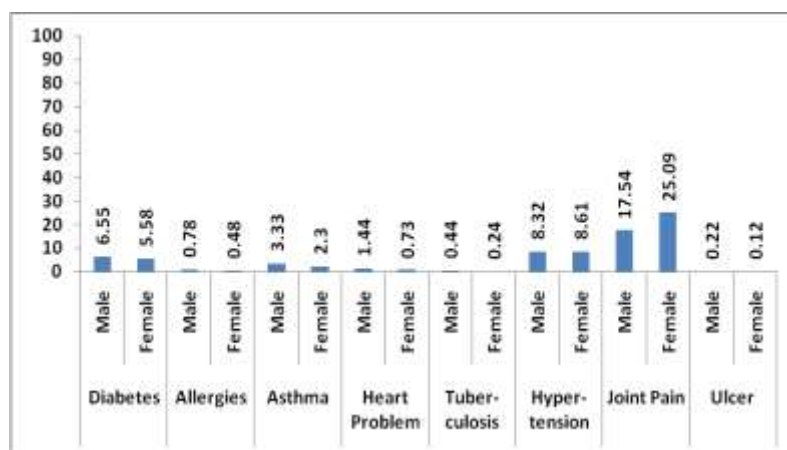
Out of all surveyed elders, almost 2.5% are reported to be disabled. Leg related disability is at above 1% level and highest among all. All other categories have reported at less than 1% level. Speaking, hearing and mental disabilities were at an insignificant level. Details are available in Table 5.1 to Table 5.7.

Habits in Elders

72% of all elders do not have any habits of intoxication which is revealed by collected data. Out of all elders who have reported one habit or the other, highest percentage (more than 9%) is using tobacco, closely followed by almost 8% beedi users and more than 5% consuming locally brewed alcohol. Gutkha and opium use were found at insignificant levels. Cigarette and foreign liquor was consumed by more than 2% elders each. Details are available in Table 6.1 to Table 6.7.

Disease Profile of Elders

Among the elders of the identified villages, joint pain has affected the highest percentage-more than 25% females and almost 18% males. More than 8% males and 8.5% females have reported to be suffering from hyper-tension. Diabetes was reported by almost 7% males and almost 6% females. More than 3% males and more than 2% females are suffering from Asthma. Almost 1.5% males and less than 1% females are having heart disease. All other diseases were reported at below 1% level. Among all diseases, in case of only joint pain percentage of affected women is marginally more than men. For details please see Table 7.1 to Table 7.8.
