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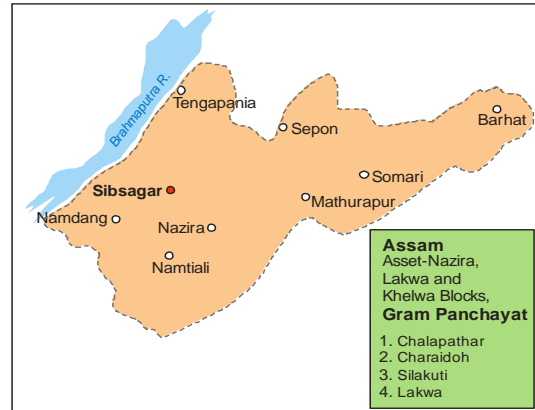


## Analysis & Findings of Baseline Survey Conducted for implementation of Mobile Health Care Programme for the Aged

### Unit: Lakwa Area (MMU MIS Location Code: 1311)

#### Background

ONGC's Assam Asset is located in Nazira in Sibsagar District. Its operational areas are spread over vast areas of the District. One of these areas is Lakwa. Under this unit the villages for proposed MMU operations were identified in consultation with ONGC senior officials. All villages of the proposed MMU operations are located in Lakwa, Sivasagar & Khelwa Blocks. Survey was accordingly organized to locate all households with elders.



#### Demography

Out of the total 1744 surveyed households, almost 83% belonged to the Below Poverty Line (BPL) category and marginally more than 17% belonged to the Above Poverty Line (APL) category. Out of the total members found in the surveyed households a total percentage of more than 37% are elders. Elder males (37.2%) are marginally more than elder females (37%). 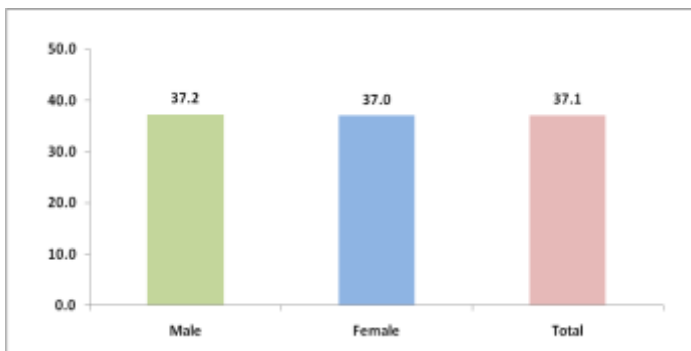


Figure-1: Percentage of Elders in the Surveyed Households

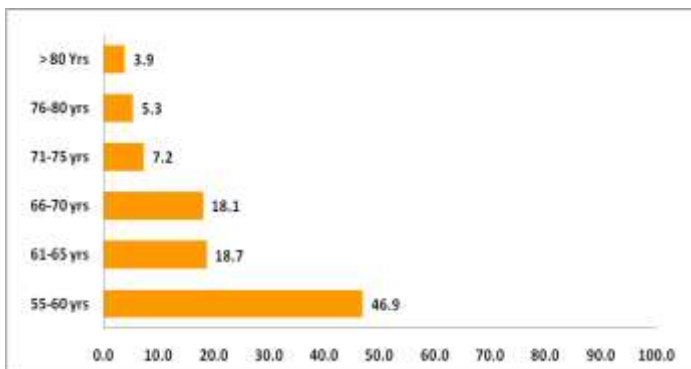


Figure-2: Percentage of Elders in Various Age Groups

While looking at data on percentage of elders in various age groups it becomes clear that as the age increases lesser and lesser elderly persons remain alive. The rate of decrease is lesser as the age group increases.

### Educational Status of Elders

Available data on educational status reveal that there is only a marginal difference in the percentages of illiterates (43.3%) and literates (42.1%). 10.1% elders are matriculates. Intermediates are 2.7% and 1.7% of them are graduates. Other two categories-diploma & PG are insignificant in percentage terms. Details are available in Table 3.1 to Table 3.8.

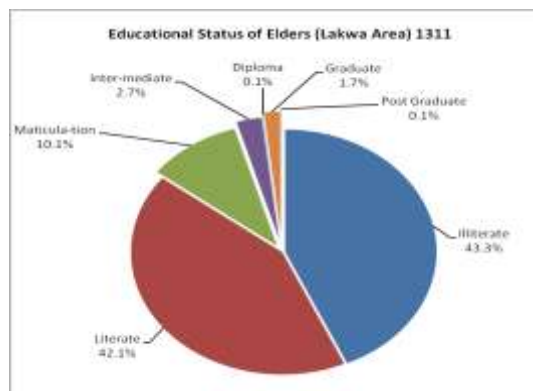


Figure-3: Educational Achievements among Elders

### Working & Non-working Elders

More than 55.5% of the elderly persons don't work. Among the working elders working elder men are way higher to working elder women in percentage terms. Among non-working elders percentage of women are much higher than that of non-working men. Working men and women were found across all age categories. Details are available in Table 4.1 and Table 4.2.

### Disability

Out of the total elders only 0.21% elders were reported to have disability of some kind or the other. Hearing, speaking and hand disabilities were reported nil. Rest all insignificant in percentage terms. Further details are available in Table 5.1 to Table 5.7.

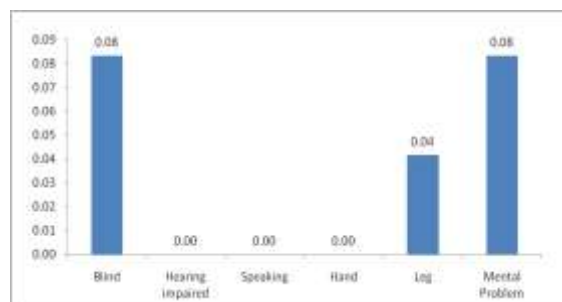


Figure-4: Disability in Elders

### Habits among Elders

Almost all elders have reported consumption of one intoxicant or the other. Out of all elders, highest percentage of them is consuming tobacco (30.1%) closely followed by elders consuming locally brewed alcohol (28.9%) and those consuming Gutkha (22.4%). Consumption of Foreign liquor is at 8.3%, Cigarette smoking is reported at 6.6% and elders consuming opium was reported at less than 1.5%.

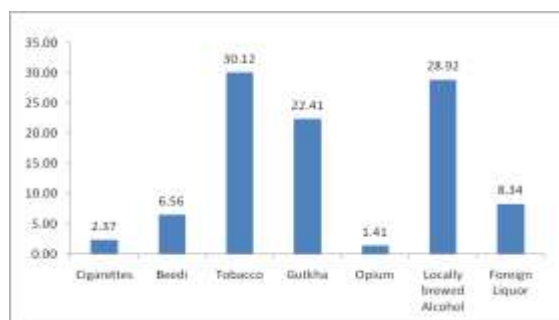


Figure-5: Habits in Elders

### Disease Profile of Elders

Among the diseases reported by the surveyed elders, joint pain was reported by highest percentage of men and women (59.7% and 46.5% respectively) followed by ulcer (almost 28% men and 14% women), hyper-tension (27% men and more than 22% women), Asthma (16.7% men and 10.6% women), Allergies (13.5% men and more than 10% women), diabetes (more than 9.5% men and more than 3% women), heart problem (more than 8.5% men and almost 5.5% women) and tuberculosis (more than 2.5% men and almost 1.5% women). 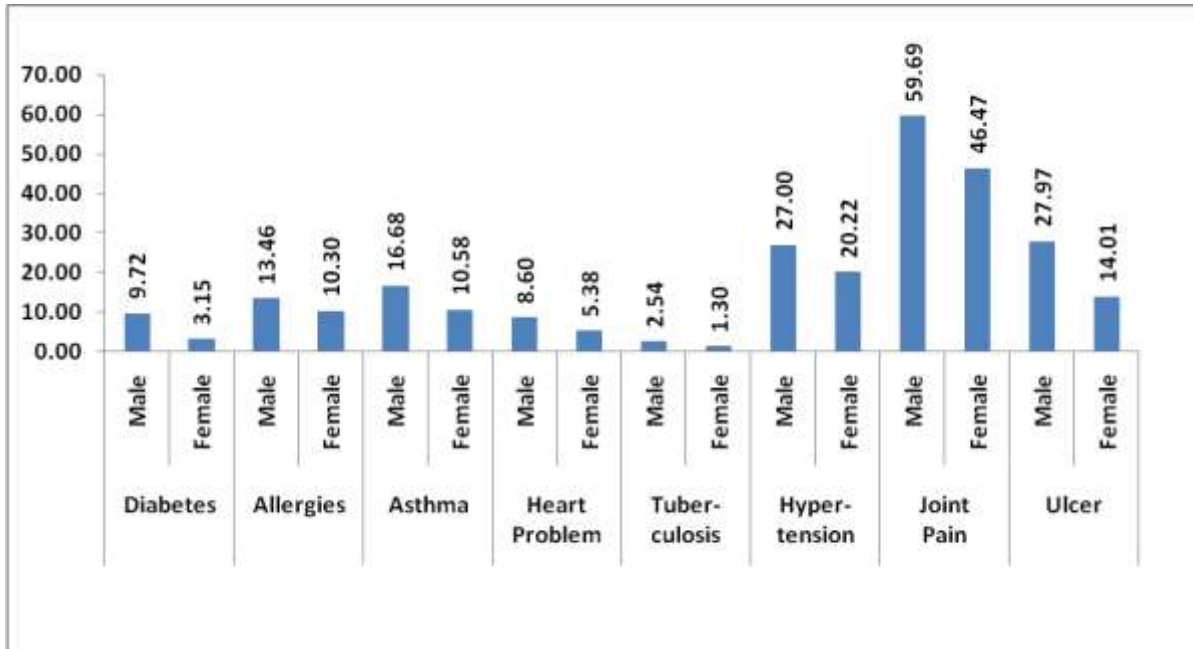


Figure-6: Disease Profile of Elders
